The **Community Engagement Programme** seeks to strengthen the understanding and ties among people of different races and religions, and build up skills and preparedness for emergencies.



CEED Alumni are community leaders who have participated in the **Community Engagement Executive Development (CEED) Programme**. This programme trains community leaders across clusters, helping to build knowledge, skills and networks of trust.

CEP Trainers are those who have gone through the **Train-the-CEP Trainer Programme** to take their CEP knowledge to a higher level. Those who have completed this programme are equipped with skills and knowledge to, in turn, help explain the CEP to their own groups, and to initiate programmes of their own.
